Achievements in Academics

1. **Board Results:** Our students demonstrated outstanding academic excellence during the 2023-24 session:
 - **Class X:** Out of 135 students, 30 achieved scores of 90% and above.
 - **Class XII:** Among 86 students, 12 scored 90% and above, showcasing the hard work of both students and faculty.
 - **4 students** received perfect score in Typography and Computer Applications (Code 817) during the board exams under the supervision of R.S. Prasad.
2. **Chairman’s Award:**

- **Plantation Drive:** All teachers contributed to the environmental restoration campaign by planting three trees to make the school eco-friendly.

The INSPIRE - MANAK (Million Minds Augmenting National Aspirations and Knowledge), being executed by DST with National Innovation Foundation – India (NIF), an autonomous body of DST, aims to motivate students in the age group of 10-15 years and studying in classes 6 to 10.
